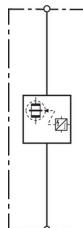

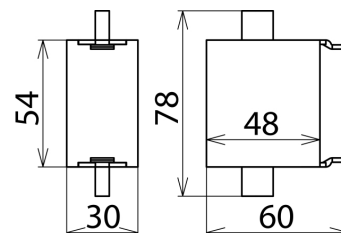
- Encapsulated RADAX Flow spark gap with high follow current limitation
