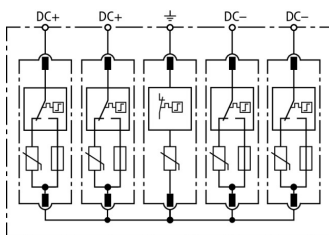


DG M PV2 SCI 1000 (952 514)

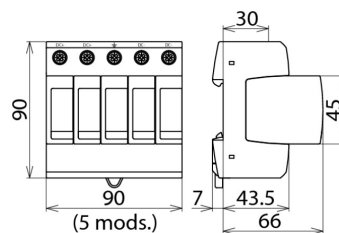
- Prewired modular complete unit for use in photovoltaic systems consisting of a base part and plug-in protection modules for protecting of two MPP-systems
